ITINERARY

DAY 1 - April 11

Arrive at Rome – Fiumicino Airport. We will meet up at the charming hotel Delle Nazioni, in the heart of Rome. The hotel location is perfect to see the best of Rome. In the evening we will be dining as a group at the hotel.

Regarding transport from the airport:

Instructions for public transportation from the airport will be provided upon booking. Or, if you wish for us to set up private transfer from the airport to the hotel for you, please let us know as soon as you can.

DAY 2 - April 12

In the morning explore Baroque Rome and some of Rome's most well-known sites, including the Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps, and the Pantheon. We will experience the Piazza Navona and the Campidoglio, one of Rome's most majestic locations. For lunch we will enjoy a tasting of Roman pizza by the Piazza Navona, followed by an afternoon of self-exploration.

DAY 3 - April 13

During the day you will be free to explore the area on your own.

We meet in the evening for a feast of new and traditional Roman cuisine at Ercoli Trastevere, where we will sample cheeses, salumi, pastas and wine carefully chosen by Tony and Gino Cuminale, the owner.

DAY 4 - April 14

Walk in the footsteps of Rome's elite with a full day in the hilltop town of Tivoli. Explore the UNESCO World Heritage sites of Villa d'Este and Villa Adriana, ornamented with impressive gardens, fountains, and sumptuous baths. Enjoy lunch with the locals at a nearby restaurant.

DAY 5- April 15

Spend the day exploring the Roman Castles. Visit the Apostolic Palace of Castel Gandolfo, which used to serve as a summer residence for the Pope. After, enjoy lunch and a wine tasting at the nearby artisanal Frascati Vineyard. Continue to the impressive Castelli Romani, a Medieval Castle with breathtaking landscapes and magnificent Renaissance gardens.

DAY 6- April 16

On this full day guided tour of Appia Antica, one of the oldest roads of Rome, explore the magnificent villas and grandiose mausoleums of Roman Emperors. Admire the well-preserved remnants of thermal baths, mosaic tile, and ancient artworks. In the evening, dine on authentic regional cuisine with fellow travelers.

DAY 7 -April 17

This day is set aside for relaxation or self exploration. If you just can't sit still, or want to see even more, you may wish to add on one of our optional tours. See Options to the left.

DAY 8 - April 18

Visit some of the most important basilicas in Rome, including San Giovanni in Laterano, considered the "Mother of all Churches," and San Pietro in Vincoli, home to Michelangelo's magnificent statue of Moses. After lunch on your own, visit the Catacombs of San Sebasiano to learn about the traditions of ancient Roman burial. In the afternoon.

DAY 9 - April 19

Discover Ostia Antica, an incredible archaeological site, rivalling Pompeii. As you walk through the ruins of docks, warehouses, mansions, shopping arcades, and baths, imagine life as it was in ancient Rome. Lunch in a typical Fiumicino restaurant to sample the city's renowned fried fish, a dish prepared with the fresh morning catch of local fishermen.

DAY 10 - April 20

Time to return home. Please let us know if you would like us to set up a private transfer from the hotel to the airport. *Arrivederci!*
